A press conference organized by the Narsingdi chapter of the National Association of Small & Cottage Industries of Bangladesh (NASCIB) expressed concern over the amendment proposal that would require retail traders to obtain licence to sell tobacco products. NASCIB denounced such proposals as 'unreasonable' and voiced concerns that such policy measure might cause loss of livelihoods for 1.5 million small and marginal businessmen.
